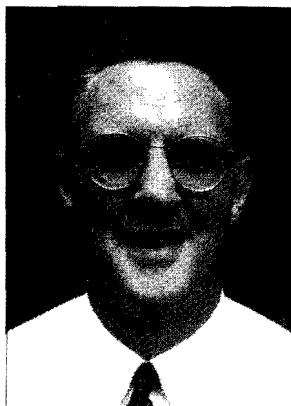
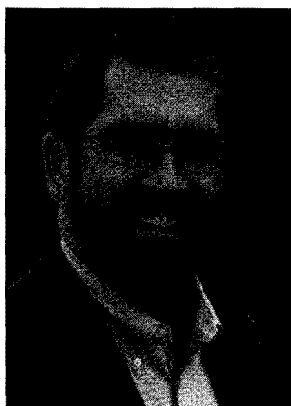



EDITORS
